I would also like to express frustration and dissatisfaction with the lack of progress in finalizing and adopting design standards for the Shingle Springs community. The Shingle Springs Community Alliance (SSCA) described the lack of progress in a November 27, 2020 letter to the EI Dorado County Planning Services. A December 2, 2020 email reply from Tiffany Schmid of Planning Services stated that the SSCA should be hearing from the Deputy Director of Public Planning and/or the Acting Planning Manager regarding resumption of the design standards project that has been halted for over one year now. There has been no reply to date. This lack of engagement sends the message that the County does not take this issue seriously. I hope that is not the case.
