THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.24.010 of Chapter 1.24 of Title 1 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code is hereby removed in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 1.24.010 of Chapter 1.24 of Title 1 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code is hereby added as follows:

1.24.010 Violation Deemed Misdemeanor. Unless the violation of a particular ordinance is specified by that ordinance to be an infraction, any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of the ordinance s of the county shall be guilty of a misdemeanor unless, in the discretion of the prosecuting attorney or agency, the matter is alleged or charged as an infraction, in which case the matter shall proceed as an infraction. A violation of the ordinances of the county that is a misdemeanor shall be punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding six months or by a fine not exceeding \$1,000, or by both. Any violation of the ordinances of the county that is an infraction shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$500, unless a different amount is provided for by a pertinent county ordinance.

Page 2 Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following adoption hereof.
