

Proclamation OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO Recognizing the El Dorado Roses

WHEREAS, the El Dorado Rose Pageant was started by the El Dorado County Fair Association in 1976 to recognize senior women residing in the County and that have been significant community volunteers; and

WHEREAS, each year at the County Fair one of the contestants is selected as the El Dorado Rose to reign over activities in this community; and

WHEREAS, these women have formed the El Dorado Rose Committee and are seen in their historic costumes at the opening of the Fair, the Wagon Train and various functions involving the Chamber of Commerce and many organizations throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, in 1985 the Rose Committee did start the Golden Rose award for a woman of such high standards but who could not fulfill the activities required of the El Dorado Rose; and

WHEREAS, each year since 1980 the Rose Committee has held the El Dorado Rose Ball which is a Gala Event and includes all of the El Dorado Roses and Golden Roses in a Grand Promenade and at which a delightful dinner is held; this year's event will be May 15;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado does hereby declare and proclaim the week of May 9 through 15, 2010 as the El Dorado Rose Week; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED, that the El Dorado Rose and her court and the past Roses and their courts are the official hostesses for the County of El Dorado.
