Case counts / rates

- County-wide cumulative totals reported cases through yesterday
 - Cases
 - Deaths
- EDC remains <u>off</u> state's monitoring list
- Glitch in state's data reporting mentioned at last board meeting fixed
 - No surprises occurred for El Dorado data when caught up

School staff/teacher screening

EDC Public Health working with EDCOE, HHSA Contracts, and CAO's Office on contracts to offer periodic screening of teachers and staff Anticipate completion and implementation in September

COVID-19 Positive student at Rescue Union School District

Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children (MIS-C)

- Child at UC Davis Hospital did not test positive for COVID with either type of testing
- Appears that the illness was not MIS-C after all
- Discharged from hospital

Although no EDC residents appear to have been afflicted with MIS-C to date after all, children elsewhere have suffered

- A good reminder that COVID infections can lead to potentially severe consequences, and
- A good reason to take precautions for avoiding COVID-19 transmissions seriously

Other Public Health Activities

- Working closely with Fire, including CAL FIRE, Law enforcement, County departments, Shingle Springs Rancheria and other community agencies to support them in keeping their workforce safe
 - Training of personnel
 - Case Investigation and Contact Tracing
 - Information
