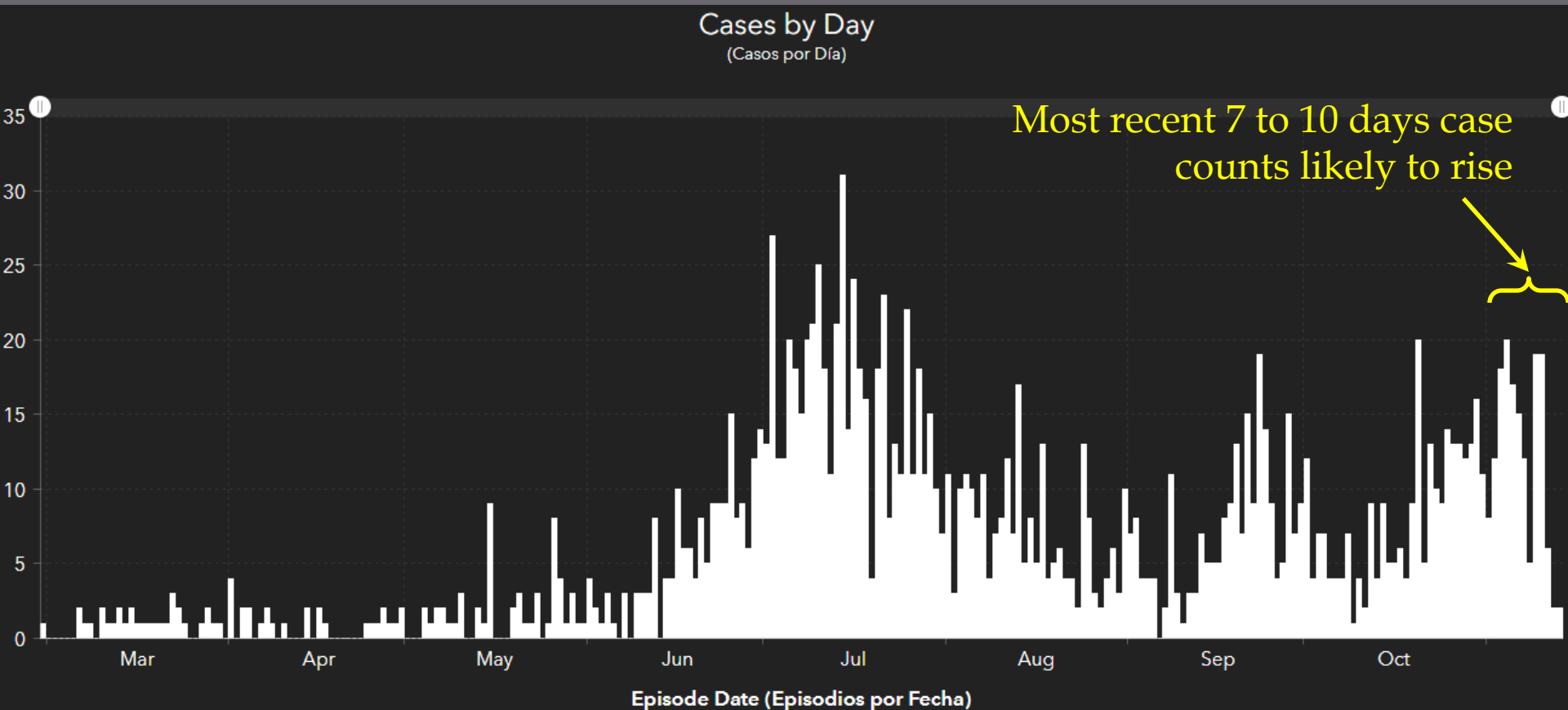

Overall trend in cases El Dorado County



EDC Tier status*

(last week)

- Assigned Tier: **Red** ← Paused by adjudication
- Assessed Tier: **Red** request (held in **Orange**)
 - 7-day average daily case rate: **5.8/100,000****
 - 7-day average testing positivity: **2.2%****
 - Lowest quartile Healthy Places Index quartile's 7-day average testing positivity: **1.1%****

EDC Tier status* (this week)

- Assigned Tier: Purple
- Assessed Tier: Purple
 - 7-day average daily case rate: 8.2/100,000**
 - 7-day average testing positivity: 3.2%**

Adjudication request of 11/11/2020 not approved

Other state-wide measures

- No longer holding counties in current tier for 2 weeks if data indicates move to stricter tier indicated; can review tiers more than 1x/wk
- New tier restrictions to be implemented within 24 hours
- Changing from 7-day lag to 4-day lag for average data viewed for tier assignments
- Travel advisory issued
 - Avoid nonessential travel out-of-state if possible
 - 14-day quarantine following out-of-state travel
- Other possibilities
 - Curfews

Closing thoughts

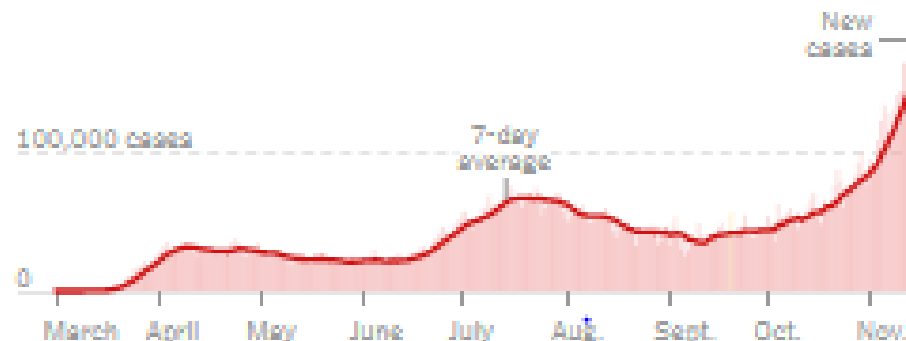
Taking voluntary protective measures will help reduce duration of and future need for business sector restrictions and will help reduce risks of hospital overcrowding
