Waste Connections of California, Inc., d/b/a Amador Disposal Service, is proud to service unincorporated El Dorado County, and remain committed to provide the best customer service possible to our customers.

Pursuant to Section 19 of the Franchise Agreement between El Dorado County and Amador Disposal Service Co Inc, and Waste Connections, Inc., please accept this correspondence as our formal request for a rate adjustment to the current collection rate schedule for our service area.

We propose an increase of 15% based on actual operating results for 2009 and projected revenues and costs for 2010 and 2011. We will provide to you our updated revenue, operating costs, and pass-through projections for 2010 and 2011 by April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 after the audit of the 2009 financial statement is complete.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that, pursuant to Section 19, Amador Disposal is entitled to a reasonable profit on its operating costs. However, we currently expect that our audited financial statements for 2009 will reflect that Amador Disposal continues, for the third year in a row, to operate at a loss.
