



Proclamation

of the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado
Recognizing the Month of June, 2021, as
Lesbian, Gay Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer (LGBTQ+)
Pride Month

WHEREAS, for more than two centuries, the founding principles and ideals of American life have included liberty, equality, freedom of expression, and the pursuit of happiness, which are intended to apply to everyone; and

WHEREAS, Martin Luther King, Jr. proclaimed that, “injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere”, inspiring real and lasting change to advance equality, respect, hope and progress, generation after generation, affording greater understanding and acceptance for all; and

WHEREAS, equality of opportunity and freedom from discrimination are fundamental to ensuring economic success and personal fulfillment; and

WHEREAS, El Dorado County celebrates diversity and recognizes the importance of its residents, visitors and employees to safely express their ethnic, cultural, racial and sexual orientation identities, which enriches our communities.
