RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO ESTABLISHING A PROCESSING FEE FOR ASSESSMENT APPEALS SUPERSEDE RESOLUTION 146-2009

WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 18 of the California Constitution empowers the Board of Supervisors in each county to adopt rules of notice and procedures for assessment appeals boards as may be required to facilitate their work and to insure uniformity in the processing and decision of equalization petitions; and

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado presently does not charge applicants a fee for processing assessment appeals applications; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to establish a processing fee in connection with the filing of assessment appeals applications; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors has proposed a fee which appears consistent with applicable legal mandates in a reasonable amount that is applied in a uniform manner; and

WHEREAS, processing fees are not refunded and must be paid at the time of filing but may be waived where the applicant would qualify for a waiver of court fees and costs pursuant to California Government Code Section 68632; and

WHEREAS, this resolution shall supersede Resolution 146-2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado hereby establishes a \$30.00 per parcel fee for Assessment Appeal application processing to be paid at the time of filing, effective July 1, 2009.
