## Proof of Publication of ORDINANCE

### SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE ORDINANCE NO. 5144

The proposed ordinance hereby amends the El Dorado County Ordinance Code Title 12 – Streets, Sidewalks and Public Places, Chapter 12.28 Traffic Impact Mitigation (TIM) Fee in its entirety. Pursuant to the Major Update to the TIM Fee program, as approved on December 8, 2020, the program's name was updated to the Traffic Impact Fee (TIF) Program. Additionally, throughout Chapter 12.28 there are references to the Community Development Agency (CDA), which has been disbanded in the time since ordinance code Section 12 was introduced in 2016. The proposed ordinance changes references to the TIM Fee Program to the TIF Program throughout, removes references to the CDA, replaced with "Department of Transportation" where appropriate, adds "CIP" to the list of definitions, defined as the "Capital Improvement Program," clarifies that the County uses the Engineering News Record Building Cost Index for adjustments of TIF amounts for inflation, and makes other non-substantive changes.

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days following the adoption thereof.
