OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO Proclaiming the Month of October, 2021, as All Colors, All Cancers Awareness Month

WHEREAS, the rate of cancers of all types continue to rise in America; and

WHEREAS, Images of Hope El Dorado has hosted the Pink in the Night Awareness Campaign throughout the month of October, in conjunction with National Breast Cancer Awareness Month since 2013; and

WHEREAS, Images of Hope's mission is to create opportunities where cancer patients, their family members, teachers and community can come participate in all aspects of the arts and foster an environment where creativity can flourish with Hope-Healing-Here, and serves all El Dorado County community members touched by cancer; and

WHEREAS, Images of Hope is launching the All Colors, All Cancers campaign to raise awareness of all types of cancers, early screenings, and art and movement therapies to all those touched by cancer; and
