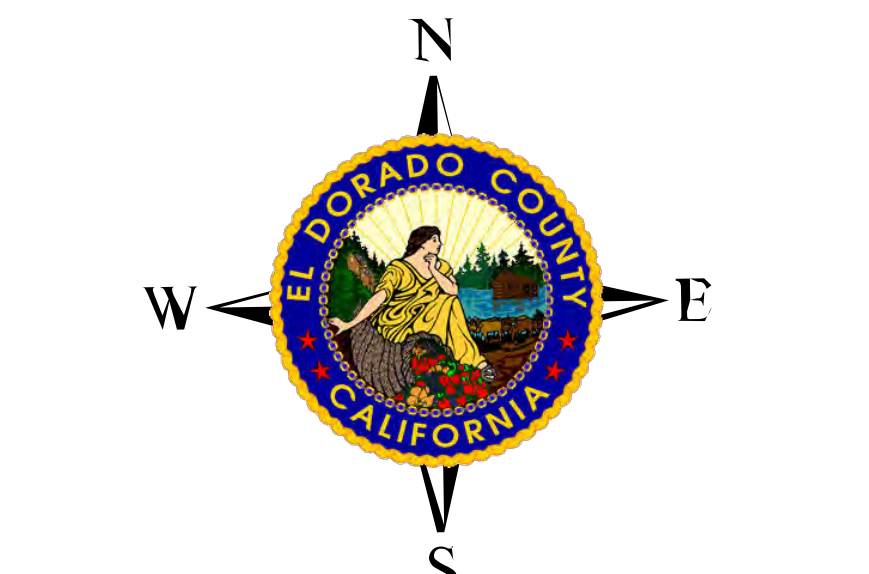


Alternative Description:
This alternative, community regions, as defined in the county's general plan, were the primary consideration for district boundaries. In addition, local centers, Community Services Districts, and the proposed El Dorado Hills city boundaries were included as secondary considerations. This alternative uniquely considers the voters of the Calaveras Fire by putting a majority of the affected population within a southern district that stretches from the western edge east to the Tahoe Basin. Lastly, this alternative combines many of the major historic areas, such as Placerville, Coloma, and Georgetown, into a common district.
