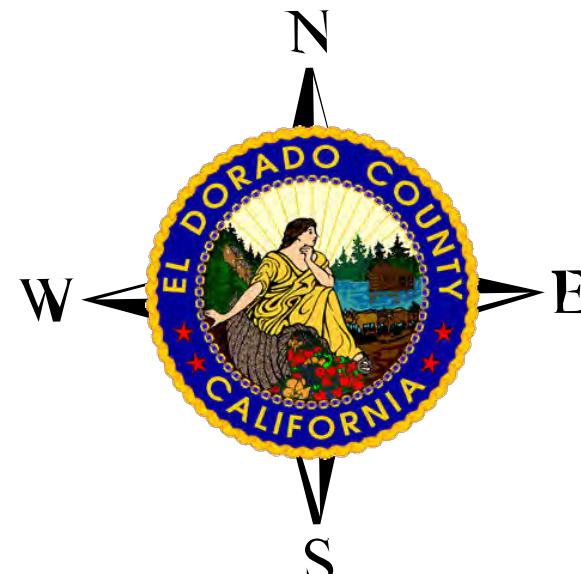


Alternative Description:
This alternative was derived by working along the Highway 50 corridor from the west to east and of county considering community services districts first and city boundaries and rural centers second. While it is not possible to prevent CSDs such as El Dorado Hills and Cameron Park from being partially split due to the high population density in those areas, the majority of CSD boundaries were kept within a district.
