- •Increase awareness of our Region: bounty, heritage, culture, activities
- Host a community event that develops awareness and demand for local products
- •Link businesses together to build long term relationships: artists and artisans with shops and galleries, wineries and growers with restaurants and retailers

Market to Table Tasting

- Tasting area shared by groups of paired Chef/ Grower(s)/ Winery
- Marketplace area with wine tasting, beer tasting, and local products such as goat cheese, honey, syrups, jams, olive oil, and soaps
- Free admittance to festival, guests can purchase tasting bracelets if they wish for \$20 for adult food and wine tasting, \$10 adult food only tasting, and \$5 for children age ten years and under

- Art and Artisan booths with pottery, painting, photography, and handmade crafts.
