**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE USE OF HIGHWAYS  
FOR THE 16th RUNNING OF THE RENO-TAHOE ODYSSEY RELAY RUN ADVENTURE  
June 3 – 4, 2022**

**WHEREAS**, Race178, Inc. in conjunction with the Tahoe-Pyramid Trail non-profit organization proposes to conduct the 16<sup>th</sup> running of the Reno-Tahoe Odyssey Relay Run Adventure event Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> and Saturday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Reno-Tahoe Odyssey Relay Run Adventure will travel along State Highway Routes 89 and 50 between the county line at Tahoma and South Lake Tahoe through Stateline between the hours of 8 p.m. on Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> and 3 a.m. Saturday, June 4<sup>th</sup>.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado approves and consents to the proposed 16<sup>th</sup> running of the Reno-Tahoe Odyssey Relay Run Adventure and recommends approval of and consents to the proposed use of State Highway Routes 89 and 50 upon terms and conditions deemed appropriate and necessary by the State of California, Department of Transportation, California Highway Patrol and South Lake Tahoe Police Department.
