11:00 A.M. - CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG

Present: 3 - Supervisor Sweeney, Supervisor Briggs and Supervisor Santiago

DEPARTMENT MATTERS:

1. <u>06-1588</u> Sheriff's Office and General Services Department recommending the following pertaining to the emergency replacement of security system at the South Lake Tahoe Jail:

(1) Find that a state of emergency exists at the South Lake Tahoe Jail as a result of the failure of the closed circuit television and intercom communication systems;

(2) Find that in accordance with County Ordinance Code 3.14.060, the County may dispense with competitive bidding requirements to immediately secure assistance from an outside vendor to perform the necessary emergency work; and

(3) Authorize Purchasing Agent to issue a purchase order for the "like" replacement of equipment and installation. (4/5 vote required) (Continued 7/17/07, Item12)

FUNDING: Accumulated Capital Outlay Fund and Criminal Justice Special Revenue Fund.

A motion was made by Supervisor Sweeney, seconded by Supervisor Santiago to approve this matter.

2. 07-1165 Sheriff's Department recommending Resolution 202-2007 continuing the Local Declaration of a State of Emergency for the South Lake Tahoe Area due to an extreme wild land fire (Angora). (4/5 vote required)

A motion was made by Supervisor Santiago, seconded by Supervisor Sweeney to adopt Resolution 202-2007.

A motion was made by Supervisor Sweeney, seconded by Supervisor Briggs to continue this matter to August 14, 2007 for the the Chief Administrative Officer and the Auditor/Controller to provide the Board with a clearer method of identifying the funding for said transfer.

(2) Dispense with competitive bidding requirements in accordance with County Ordinance Code 3.14.060, so that the County may immediately secure assistance from outside vendors to perform necessary emergency work; and

(3) Authorize Purchasing Agent to issue purchase orders as necessary to ensure the continuation of County services and operations. (Cont'd 7/17/07, Item 36) (4/5 vote required)

- 7. 07-1299 Chief Administrative Office recommending Chairman be authorized to sign Budget Transfer transferring \$1.5 million from contingency to fund emergency tree debris removal in the Angora Fire burn area. (4/5 vote required)

A motion was made by Supervisor Sweeney, seconded by Supervisor Santiago to approve the contingency fund transfer in the amount of \$1.5 million with the admonition that contracts for the removal of tree debris shall not be issued until an information item is on the next agenda (August 14, 2007) showing risk of liability from the operation and for the trees remaining.

(4/5 vote required)
