Supervisor Santiago recommends the Board consider impact of the King Fire and take urgent action as appropriate inclusive of consideration of all necessary resolutions; and authorize the Chair, in her capacity as Director of Emergency Services, to request the Governor and President to proclaim a state of emergency; to apply for and secure emergency program services from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services; and authorize the Chair to execute any and all consultant services, contracts, and purchase orders for goods and services in connection with the emergency, to be treated in accordance with County Code Section 2.42.110.

A motion was made by Supervisor Mikulaco, seconded by Supervisor Frentzen to add an Addendum to the Agenda for September 17, 2014. This item will remain open throughout the day in order to accommodate updates.
