## NEW BUSINESS

1. [21-1730](#) Discuss and vote on possible methods of communication, sharing of information, and the Commission's position regarding the El Dorado County Probation Department's Juvenile Hall Construction project going before the Board of Supervisors at their regular meeting on November 2, 2021. (Chair Huscher)

*There was a discussion on the possible recommendation(s) of the Commission to the Board of Supervisors regarding the construction of a new Juvenile Hall in Placerville. One option would be to recommend two facilities; one on the West Slope and the other in the South Lake Tahoe Basin. The second option would be to recommend both facilities, but acknowledge that if that were not possible, to have at least one facility rather than sending youth out of County.*

A motion was made to vote on Option 1, which was the recommendation of two facilities. The motion did not pass. All voted no.

A motion was made to vote on Option 2, which was the recommendation of two facilities, but with the request that if that were not possible, to have at least one facility so that local youth would not be sent out of County. The motion was approved unanimously.
