Background: The California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) offers the Tire-Derived Product (TDP) Grant Program to promote markets for recycled-content products derived from waste tires generated in California and decrease the adverse environmental impacts created by unlawful

disposal and stockpiling of waste tires.

Reason for Recommendation: This grant is to help divert waste tires from landfill disposal as well as eliminating the stockpiling of waste tires. The Environmental Management Department will partner with the El Dorado County Fair 501c organization for this grant opportunity. If awarded, the funds will be used to supply and install tire-derived asphalt at the El Dorado County Fairgrounds.
