Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost

Subsequent to approval by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the County Department of Transportation (Department), in accordance with the Federal Apportionment Exchange/State Match Program Agreement (Agreement), will allocate \$359,164 for various transportation improvement projects. The State Matching funds of \$100,000 will be allocated for use

as a match on existing and anticipated federally funded transportation projects as the first priority before applying these funds to any other road related purpose. The portion allocated to the Tahoe Basin will be used for routine maintenance.

Background

Section 182.6 of the Streets and Highways Code authorizes the County to exchange the assigned Federal apportionments made available to the County under the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient, Transportation Equity Act - A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU), Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP), for nonfederal State Highway Account funds.

In accordance with the Agreement, \$359,164 in Federal funding (Section 182.6 of the Streets and Highways Code) is being exchanged for a like amount of State funds. An additional \$100,000 of State Matching funds (Section 182.9 of the Streets and Highways Code) is also being made available. By exchanging the Federal monies with State monies, funds become less restrictive in use.

Reason for Recommendation

This recommended action will allow the Road Fund to receive \$459,164 of State revenue. The RSTP funds and the State Match funds are included in the Department's proposed FY 2012-2013 Budget.

Action(s) to be taken following Board approval

1. Clerk of the Board to have Chair sign the two original Agreements, (State Agreement No X12-5925 (113), County AGMT 12-53478).
2. Clerk of the Board will forward two partially-executed original Agreements to the Department for further processing.
3. Department will forward two partially-executed original Agreements to Caltrans for their review, approval and signature.
4. Department will forward a fully-executed original Agreement to the Clerk of the Board for filing.
5. Department will prepare an invoice to obtain the available funding.
