There is no Net County Cost associated with this Agreement. Sufficient appropriations were included in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2012-13 budget and are included in the FY 2013-14 County Budget Request.

Background

Agreement 224-S1310 with Grace Home was approved and executed by the Purchasing Agent on October 30, 2012 with a maximum obligation of \$61,344 for the term of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013. In January 2013 it became apparent that usage of the facility was higher than anticipated and Amendment I was developed to increase the compensation of the Agreement to ensure continued

availability of services, as well as extension of the term to ensure ongoing services in FY 2013-14. Incidental revisions were also made in Amendment I to address payment for Board and Care for those persons on Social Security Income.

Reason for Recommendation

The Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) recommends Board approval of this Amendment I to Agreement 244-S1310 to ensure the continued availability of required services on an "as requested" basis.
