Health Services Department recommending the Board ratify the Director's signature on Modification B-1 to the County's Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreement 07-77309-000 with the State of California, Department of Mental Health, extending the term of the Agreement through June 30, 2013.

**FUNDING:** State Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Funds.

Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost:

There is no fiscal impact associated with MHSA Agreement Modification B-1 which extends the term only. The State will provide a subsequent contract modification to incorporate the specific funding allocation for FY 2009-10.

Background:

In November 2004, California voters passed Proposition 63, now known as the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA). In January 2006, the Board approved submittal to the State of the Department's three-year plan for MHSA Community Services and Support. This three-year plan was formally approved by the State on April 28, 2006, and El Dorado County was authorized to receive MHSA funding effective the first day of the month of approval (April 1, 2006).

On April 1, 2008 the Board approved the updated Agreement Number 07-77309-000 that extended the contract term to June 30, 2008 and provided reimbursement for spending related to MHSA implementation costs back to July 1, 2004, and adopted resolution 86-2008 with the *intent* of authorizing the Director to sign subsequent Agreement modifications that did not affect either the funding amount or term. The actual resolution that was signed by the Board Chairman *did not* include these limitations.

On June 3, 2008 the Board approved and authorized the Mental Health Director to sign Modification

A-1 to the MHSA Agreement extending the contract term an additional year to June 30, 2009, allowing Mental Health to continue providing approved services and receive future funding. MHSA Agreement Modifications A-2 through A-6 were processed by the State to incorporate plan modifications and future funding, with no signature required by the County.

Reason for Recommendation:

In April 2009, the State Department of Mental Health provided the Health Services Department with MHSA Agreement Modification B-1 extending the term of the MHSA Agreement through June 30, 2013. MHSA Agreement Modification B-1 was signed by the Director under the authority documented in the resolution signed by the Board Chairman on April 1, 2008 which did not reflect limited signature authority.

Resolution 86-2008 has subsequently been corrected and now reflects the intended limited authority of the Director to sign MHSA amendments that do not affect the funding amount or term. Accordingly, the Department is requesting the Board ratify the Director's signature on Agreement Modification B-1 in conformance with the corrected resolution.

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
