Background:

Reason for Recommendation:

The State Library has provided grant funding for the purpose of encouraging libraries to develop library services for parents and child care providers and to create "family friendly" spaces in libraries for families of infants, toddlers and preschoolers. This grant will allow the library to purchase the materials needed to implement programming for infants and toddlers at all branch libraries.
