### Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost

No change to Net County Cost. The Cameron Park Library is funded primarily from taxes and charges for services (76%) with a Net County Cost of \$104,157 (24%).

### **Background**

On July 2, 1993 the Board adopted Resolution 225-93 establishing a library benefit assessment for the operation of the Cameron Park Branch Library. An advisory vote in June 1994 received a 53% majority in favor of continuing the assessment. The assessment is necessary to fund most of the operating costs of the Cameron Park Library (staff, books, utilities).

### **Reason for Recommendation**

County Service Area law requires an annual public hearing to receive comment regarding the continuation of the assessment. The amount of the assessment is \$25 per dwelling unit, with exceptions for apartments which are assessed at \$20 and mobile homes in parks which are assessed at \$12.50. The assessment has remained unchanged since 1993.
