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### DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND

The State of California Division of Boating and Waterways provides the Sheriff's Office with an annual grant for an intervention program on the County's lakes and waterways. As an extension of that program, the State also offers equipment grants for items above and beyond the cost of the day to day operation of the boat patrol program.

This grant cycle the State has awarded the Sheriff's Office funding toward the purchase of four PWCs and two towing Trailers that will allow for patrol in multiple bodies of water. Upon acceptance of this funding, the Sheriff's Office will begin the procurement process for this equipment. The goal is for the Sheriff's Office to acquire PWCs that can be utilized year-round in various bodies of water.
