Background: The Equitable Sharing Agreement is entered into between the Federal Government, the El Dorado County Sheriff and the Governing Body of the County, and sets forth the requirements for participation in the Federal Equitable Sharing Program, including the restrictions upon the use of the federally forfeited cash, property, proceeds, and any interest earned thereon, which are equitably shared with participating law enforcement agencies.

Reason for Recommendation: Receipt by the Department of Justice of the signed Equitable Sharing Agreement and Annual Certification Report is a prerequisite to the Sheriff receiving any equitably shared cash, property or proceeds.

Action to be taken following Board approval: The Chairman of the Board will sign the Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification and it will be sent to the United States Department of Justice.
