Recorder-Clerk/Registrar of Voters recommending the Board approve the following appointments of Directors to Special Districts in lieu of the election held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010.

### EL DORADO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

(Supervisory Districts II, III and IV)

Vacancies: Two Directors (full terms) qualified & elected by Division

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees that filed: Joe Rose (Division 2) and Mark Johnson (Division 3).

### GEORGETOWN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (Supervisory District IV)

Vacancy: One Director at Large (unexpired 2 year term)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint one nominee that filed: Rod Williams.

### LAKE VALLEY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (Supervisory Districts II & V)

Vacancies: Two Directors at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees that filed: Dave Huber and Robert Rossi.

### MOSQUITO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (Supervisory District IV)

Vacancies: Three Directors at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint three nominees that filed: John Moalli, Richard Rood and Joseph Snyder.

### BLACK OAK MINE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisory District IV)

Vacancies: Two Governing Board Members qualified by Trustee Area and Elected at Large

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees that filed: Mel Allen, Trustee Area 1 (unexpired 2 year term) and Rodger Musso, Trustee Area 2 (full term).

### BUCKEYE UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisory District I, II & IV)

Vacancies: Three Governing Board Members at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint three nominees that filed: Brenda Hanson-Smith, Winston Pingrey and Karen Randall.

### CAMINO UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisory District II, III & IV)

Vacancies: Three Governing Board Members at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint three nominees that were recommended by the Board of Directors: Suzanne Egger, Scott Robbins and Maria Rosas.

### GOLD TRAIL UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisory Districts III and IV)

Vacancies: Three Governing Board Members at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint three nominees that filed: Julie Bauer, Brian Bockie and Lauren Keith.

### INDIAN DIGGINGS SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisory District II)

Vacancies: Two Governing Board Members at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees that filed: Joetta Longtin and Daniel Smith.

LATROBE SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisorial District II)

Vacancies: Two Governing Board Members at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees that filed: Jim Bales and Brad Silverbush.

MOTHER LODE UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisorial District II, III & IV)

Vacancies: Three Governing Board Members at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees that filed: Karen Jones and John Parker. Appoint one nominee recommended by the Board of Directors: Cory Cahill.

RESCUE UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisorial Districts I, II & IV)

Vacancy: One Governing Board Member at Large (unexpired 2 year term)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint one nominee that filed: Erike Young.

SILVER FORK SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisorial District II & IV)

Vacancies: Two Governing Board Members at Large (full terms)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees recommended by the Directors of the District: Robert Bowman and James Ussery.

SIERRA JOINT COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (Supervisorial District IV)

Vacancies: Two Governing Board Members (full terms) qualified by Trustee Area and Elected at Large

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees that filed: Dave Ferrari (Trustee Area 2) and Nancy Palmer (Trustee Area 6).

TAHOE TRUCKEE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (Supervisorial District V)

Vacancies: Three Governing Board Members (full terms) qualified by Trustee Area and Elected at Large

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint two nominees that filed: Kim Szluzerek (Trustee Area 1) and Dianna Driller (Trustee Area 5). Trustee Area 4 remains VACANT.

EL DORADO COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

(Supervisorial Districts I, II, III, IV and V)

Vacancies: Three Governing Board Members (full terms) qualified and elected by Trustee Areas

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint three nominees that filed: Matt Boyer (Trustee Area 1), John Lane (Trustee Area 2) and Heidi Weiland (Trustee Area 4).

GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RECREATION DISTRICT (Supervisorial District IV)

Vacancies: Five Directors qualified by Area, elected at Large

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint five nominees that filed. Full Terms: Mary Sartori (Greenwood/Area 3) and Aloha Adams (Cool/Area 4); Unexpired 2 Year Terms: Esther Prunella (Georgetown/Area 1), Kenneth Spencer (Garden Valley/Kelsey/Area 2), and Kris Syversen (Pilot Hill/Area 5).

TAHOE CITY PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT (Supervisorial District IV and V)

Vacancy: One Director at Large (full term)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Appoint one nominee that filed: Lou Reinkens (Seat No. 2).

GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT (Supervisorial District IV)

Vacancy: Two Directors (full term) must be Landowner within the District and elected at Large

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Appoint one nominee that filed: William Bennett and appoint one nominee recommended by Directors of the District: David Jordan.

CAMERON ESTATES COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

(Supervisory District II)

Vacancies: Three Directors at Large (full terms)

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Appoint three nominees that filed: Doris Miller, Smokey Riggert, and James Sholl.

GARDEN VALLEY RANCH/ESTATES COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT (Supervisory District IV)

Vacancies: Two Directors at Large (full terms)

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Appoint two nominees that filed: Frances Clark and Frank Clark.

ROLLING HILLS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

(Supervisory District II)

Vacancy: Three Directors at Large

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Appoint two nominees that filed: Tim Halverson (full term) and William Grava (unexpired two year term) and one position (full term) remains vacant.

Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost: None

Reason for Recommendation: Pursuant to Election Code 10515, the Board of Supervisors must make the appointments of Special Districts that will not appear on the November 2, 2010 ballot due to either an insufficient number or absence of nominees. The Board shall appoint all candidates who have filed declarations of candidacy and may appoint any nominees who have been recommended by the Directors of the District or the public. The nominees appointed shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a general district election for the office.

Action to be taken following Board approval: Return signed minute order to the Registrar of Voters.
