Department of Transportation recommending the Board:
1) Make findings pursuant to Article II, Section 210 b (6) of the El Dorado County Charter that there are specialty skills required for the work to be performed under this Amendment that are not expressly identified in County classifications; and
2) Authorize the Chair to sign the First Amendment to Agreement for Services No. 870-S0911 with Sycamore Environmental Consultants, Inc., extending the term of the Agreement from September 14, 2012 to the later of County's recordation of Notices of Acceptance for projects or resolution of all construction claims, if any, associated with the projects.

Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost

There is no fiscal impact associated with this agenda item. Funding for the Amendment will be provided by Highway Bridge Program funds.

Background

On September 15, 2009 the Board approved Agreement for Services No. 870-S0911 with Sycamore Environmental Consultants, Inc. for a not-to-exceed amount of \$240,000 for a three-year term to assist the Department of Transportation (Department) with environmental review services for the Rubicon Trail Area projects: Rubicon Trail at Ellis Creek - Bridge Replacement Project (CIP No. 77117) and Wentworth Springs Road at Gerle Creek - Bridge Replacement Project (CIP No. 77118).

Reason for Recommendation

Both bridge replacement projects have encountered delays related to agency coordination and permitting processes and approval. The purpose of the Amendment is to extend the expiration date of the Agreement from September 14, 2012 to the County's recordation of Notices of Acceptance for the projects or resolution of all construction claims, if any, associated with the projects. This change will ensure that expiration of the Agreement coincides with the completion of the work for the projects. There are no changes to the Scope of Work or the not-to-exceed compensation amount of the Agreement.

The Purchasing Agent reviewed and provided approval of the Department's request to process the Amendment for environmental review services and concurs that the Department's request is in compliance with Board of Supervisors Policy C-17.

Board approval of this Amendment is required pursuant to Board of Supervisors Policy C-17 due to the term of the Agreement exceeding three years.

The El Dorado County Employees Association, Local #1, has been informed of this proposed Amendment.

Action(s) to be taken following Board approval

1. The Acting Clerk of the Board will obtain the Chair's signature on the two originals of the First Amendment to Agreement for Services No. 870-S0911.
2. The Acting Clerk of the Board will forward one fully executed original to the Department for further processing.
