Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost

There is no impact to Net County Cost. The Veterans Affairs Commission special revenue fund currently has \$6,659 available for use by the Veteran Affairs Commission. These funds were received in February 2005 as a donation to the Veterans Affairs Commission.
