## **Reason for Recommendation**

The retiring officers will pay the fair market value as listed in the annual Blue Book of Gun Values in accordance with Public Contract Code 10334. The sale price of each weapon will be \$300.00 plus tax.

The weapons to be declared as surplus are:
