FUNDING: Road Fund (Non-General Fund)

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION: On December 6, 2005, item #34, the Board awarded Bid #06-288-042 for the purchase of Plant Mix Asphalt Concrete for road maintenance on the East Slope. The vendor has agreed to extend pricing for twelve (12) additional months. Board of Supervisors Policy C-17, 5.9 (f), allows the Purchasing Agent to extend a contract award from the previous contract period provided that the vendor agrees to provide the item(s) at the same price and under the same terms and conditions as the previous award. These extensions allow the County to take advantage of the prior year low bid pricing.

FISCAL IMPACT/CHANGE TO NET COUNTY COST: Procurement and Contracts has been advised that funding is available within the Department of Transportation's Road Fund budget.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN FOLLOWING APPROVAL: Following Board approval, the Procurement and Contracts Division will increase the blanket purchase order to Tahoe Asphalt of South Lake Tahoe,

CA, in the amount of \$156,000.00.
