Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost:

Funding for the project will come from the Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee Program (TIM). There is no net County cost associated with this agenda item.

Reason for Recommendation:

The project is subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); the preparation of a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration has been completed and was approved by your Board on June 5, 2007 and the Notice of Determination was filed on June 6, 2007.

The research of all potentially affected parcels, and the acquisitions of portions of the subject parcels, are necessary from the subject property owners to enable the construction of the project. In order for the Department of Transportation (DOT) to prepare for negotiations with the subject parcel owners, DOT staff is requesting authorization from your Board to proceed with the acquisition process, including the ordering of, and payment for, title reports and obtaining certified appraisals of the land rights to be acquired.

Action to be taken following Board approval:

Right of Way Unit staff will proceed with the acquisition process for the subject parcels referenced herein, including the ordering of and payment for title reports, and obtaining certified appraisals for portions of the subject parcels necessary to construct the project.
