Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost: There is no increase in net County cost. The approved FY 2007-08 Development Services budget includes funding for this agreement. As this service will

only be available to Angora Fire related building permit applications the department will request reimbursement from the State Office of Emergency Services.

Background: On June 24, 2007, 254 residential structures were destroyed, 75 other structures; and 35 residential structures were damaged in what became known as the Angora Fire. With the recent reductions in force experienced by Development Services and the increased workload generated by the Angora Fire related building permit applications, the department requires "as requested" building plan check services to process Angora related building permit applications. Additionally, the California Health and Safety Code Sections 17960.1 and 19837 mandate that, after specific waiting periods, the department employs a private entity on a temporary basis to perform the plan checking function if so requested by the applicant.

Beginning in 1998, the BOS authorized the department to contract with outside plan check firms. By adding this consultant specifically to provide plan review services on an "as requested" basis for properties affected by the Angora Fire, we will be able to maintain our current level of customer service.

Reason for Recommendation: This agreement will provide Development Services Department the opportunity to provide building plan review services on an "as requested" basis to Angora Fire property owners.

Action to be taken following Board approval: Board Chair to sign the agreement with the consultant. Board Clerk's Office will forward the executed agreement to Development Services for distribution.
