DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND

The Approval Authority, established by the Board to administer the use of Homeland Security Grant funds, has approved the reimbursement of \$4,000 to the City of Placerville from the Fiscal Year 2016 Homeland Security Grant for the purchase of a Video Monitoring System. The Approval Authority consists of representatives from the City of Placerville, City of South Lake Tahoe, the Sheriff's Office, Fire Districts, and other eligible governmental agencies.

ALTERNATIVES

Failure to disburse funds would result in the inability of the Sheriff's Office to administer the grant funds as approved by the State and the Approval Authority.
