Chief Administrative Office recommending the Board submit language clarifying the Board's policy role and relationship to the Chief Administrative Office to the Charter Review Committee as stated in the Strategic Direction Framework adopted on February 24, 2009. (Refer to file 09-0086, Item 45)

Background: On February 24, 2009 the Board adopted an 18-month Strategic Direction Framework which outlined the Board's strategic priorities as well as goals and objectives for achieving those priorities. Among the objectives was the Board's desire to "Model Governance by Policy." With this item the Board intended to, "submit language clarifying the Board's policy role and relationship to [the] CAO to the Charter Review Committee" by March 15, 2009.
