Background: Request to consider General Plan Amendment A08-0013/Hazard Mitigation Plan initiated by EL DORADO COUNTY SHERIFF to amend Objective 6.1.1 and Policy 6.1.1.1 to incorporate the Hazard Mitigation Plan into the Public Health, Safety, and Noise Element of the General Plan pursuant to Assembly Bill AB2140 which was passed into law on January 1, 2007.
