DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND

President Gerald Ford declared November 3, 1974 through November 10, 1974 as the first "National Emergency Medical Services Week." This annual observance continued for four more years. It was re-instituted by The American College of Emergency Physicians in 1982, which moved the observance of EMS Week from November to September. In 1992, the observance of EMS Week was moved to the third week in May.

National Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Week brings together local communities and medical personnel to publicize safety and honor the dedication of those who provide the day-to-day lifesaving services of medicine's "front line." This year, the annual EMS Week will be celebrated throughout the Nation beginning May 16, 2021 through May 22, 2021. Each of the five days has a theme that represents the diverse nature of EMS:

- Monday EMS Education Day
- Tuesday Safety Tuesday

- Wednesday EMS for Children Day
- Thursday Save-A Life Day (CPR & Stop the Bleed)
- Friday EMS Recognition Day

In conjunction with this proclamation, the El Dorado County Emergency Services Authority (West Slope JPA) and the California Tahoe Emergency Services Operations Authority (CalTahoe JPA) will give presentations to the Board regarding their emergency personnel's outstanding contributions and dedication to their respective organizations.
