Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost: There will be a net county cost decrease as a result of the increased funding received from the department of insurance.

Background: The District Attorney's Office has had the Automobile Insurance Fraud grant since fiscal year 04/05. El Dorado County has been commended by the California Department of Insurance for program operation and compliance.
