Chief Administrative Office, Procurement and Contracts on behalf of Community Development Agency, Transportation Division, recommending the Board consider the following:

1) Award Bid No. 15-288-049 for the purchase of Plant Mix Asphalt Concrete for the West Slope of El Dorado County to the low qualified bidder, Teichert Aggregates of Sacramento, CA;

2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue a blanket purchase order in the amount of \$1,100,000.00 for a twenty-four (24) month period following Board approval; and

3) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to increase the blanket purchase order on an "as needed" basis during the awarded period as long as funding is available within the requesting department's budget.
