Chief Administrative Office, District Attorney and Sheriff's Office recommending the Board approve and ratify the Sheriff's signature on the award documents for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Fiscal Year 2015 in the amount of \$15,842 for additional training funds for the Sheriff's Office, and training and purchase of law enforcement equipment and supplies for the District Attorney's office.

FUNDING: Justice Assistance Grant Program, General Fund and CalMMET Funds. **DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDATION**

The CAO, DA, and Sheriff's Office are recommending the Board approve and accept the award and ratify the Sheriffs signature on the Grant Award document for Justice Assistance Grant Program funds.

DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND

The Sheriff's Office and DA's recently requested Board authorization to submit an application for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Fiscal Year 2015 funds. The grant has been awarded in the amount of \$15,842. The Sheriff's Office will receive \$7,921 to partially fund sending eight Detectives to the California Narcotic Officers Association (CNOA) Annual Training Institute. The remaining \$4,479 needed will be funded by CalMMET special revenue funds.

The DA's Office will receive \$7,921 to partially fund sending four DA Investigators to the California District Attorney Investigators Association (CDAIA) Annual Training Conference, and to purchase law enforcement tactical supplies. The remaining funds needed will be funded by General Funds already budgeted in the DA's operational budget.

The signed Agreement was due back to the Department of Justice by October 4, 2015, which necessitates this request to ratify the Sheriff's signature.
