Transportation Department recommending adoption of Resolution **208-2008** accepting the Irrevocable Offer of Dedication from Carolyn M. Uchikura, for road right of way, including the underlying fee, along with landscape and public service easements, located on the property identified as APN 119-100-15-100 in El Dorado Hills, necessary in order to accommodate construction of Bass Lake Road Reconstruction Project 66109. **RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Approve.

Reason for Recommendation:

The Department of Transportation has received an Irrevocable Offer of Dedication for road right of way, including the underlying fee, along with landscape and public service easements. Said dedication is being made by Carolyn M. Uchikura . The subject property is identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 119-100-15-100 and is located on Bass Lake Road, in El Dorado Hills. Said right of way is more particularly described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, which are attached to said Irrevocable Offer of Dedication. Said dedication is being made pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the Bass Lake Hills Specific Plan Development Agreement and is necessary in order to accommodate the construction of Bass Lake Road Reconstruction Project #66109.

The Department of Transportation's staff has reviewed said offer and recommends that the Board adopt and authorize the Chairman to sign the Resolution accepting said offer, at this time. Authorization for recording said offer is pursuant to Government Code Section 7050.

Action to be taken following Board approval:

1. Said Resolution, Irrevocable Offer of Dedication and Exhibits will be recorded.

2. Copies of the recorded Resolution, Irrevocable Offer of Dedication and Exhibits will be sent to the property owner.
