Sheriff's Office recommending the Board approve and authorize the Chair to sign and execute Reimbursement Agreement 278-O1811 between the County and City of Placerville for reimbursement of funds in the amount of \$7,000 for the grant performance period that ends May 31, 2018 from the Fiscal Year (FY) 2015 Homeland Security Grant for the purchase of two years of License Plate Reader maintenance for the Placerville Police Department.

FUNDING: FY 2015 Homeland Security Grant.

DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDATION

The Sheriff's Office recommends the signing and execution of the Reimbursement Agreement in order to complete the disbursement of funds that were allocated to the City of Placerville by the Grant's Approval Authority which oversees the administration of these funds for the prevention, response, and recovery from various terrorism/security incidents.

DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND

The Approval Authority, established by the Board to administer the use of Homeland Security Grant funds, has approved the reimbursement of \$7,000 to the City of Placerville from the FY 2015 Homeland Security Grant for the purchase of two years of License Plate Reader maintenance. The Approval Authority consists of representatives from the City of Placerville, City of South Lake Tahoe, the Sheriff's Office, Fire Districts, and other eligible governmental agencies.

ALTERNATIVES

Failure to disburse funds would result in the inability of the Sheriff's Office to administer the grant funds as approved by the State and the Approval Authority.
