Transportation Department recommending the Board accept the subdivision improvements for Serrano Village J4 as substantially complete; reduce Performance Bond 929347745 by \$223,058.61 to \$218,896.50 to guarantee against any defective work, labor done or defective materials furnished and release after one year if no claims are made; and hold Laborer and Materialsmen Bond 929347745 in the amount of \$1,094,482.50 to guarantee payment to persons furnishing labor, materials or equipment and release after six months if conditions are met. **RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Approve.

Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost:

There is no immediate or short-term fiscal impact associated with action, as the Serrano - El Dorado Owners Association will maintain the roads.

Reason for Recommendation:

The Subdivision Improvements for Serrano Village J4 have been substantially completed according to the plans, specifications and conditions of the Agreement to Make Subdivision Improvements to Class I Subdivisions Between the County and Owner dated November 15, 2005.

The Performance Bond No. 929347745 in the amount of \$1,827,201.00, which was previously reduced to \$441,995.11, is being reduced by \$223,058.61 to \$218,896.50 which is 10% of the total improvements. This amount guarantees against any defective work, labor done or defective materials furnished.

The Laborer and Materialmens Bond No. 929347745 for \$1,094,482.50, as amended in the August

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15, 2005, General Purpose Rider, guarantees payment to persons furnishing labor, materials or equipment.

Action to be taken following Board approval:

- 1) The Clerk of the Board will:
 - a.) Reduce the Performance Bond No. 929347745 to \$218,896.50.
 - b.) Hold Laborer and Materialmens Bond No. 929347745 for \$1,094,482.50.
- 2) The Department will request the Clerk of the Board release the Performance Bond after one year and the Laborer and Materialmens Bond after six months, if listed conditions are met.
