Background:

On September 7, 2005, the Golden Sierra Governing Board approved the establishment of El Dorado County as the first Consortium Operator under the Local Workforce Investment Act Program, effective July 1, 2006. On November 8, 2005, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 339-2005 authorizing an Amended and Restated Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement for Golden Sierra Job Training Agency, including a provision giving the JPA the ability to pass El Dorado County's share of funds to the County to enable the County to provide job training services. The Golden Sierra Workforce Investment Board and their Governing Board approved the El Dorado/Alpine County Local Operator Business Plan on April 24, 2006 and April 26, 2006 respectively. On June 20, 2006, the Board of Supervisors approved establishment of a budget and approved Human Services staffing for implementation of Workforce Investment Act Program activities effective July 1, 2006.

Reason for Recommendation:

The El Dorado County Department of Human Services Business Plan identifies partners to the local operations of the workforce investment activities in El Dorado and Alpine Counties. Job One, as an identified partner, assists in providing comprehensive One Stop Resource Center services to the community. The Resource Sharing Agreement establishes a formal cooperative working relationship among the parties and defines resources to be shared with respect to continuation of an integrated, expanded One Stop career center delivery system. The Blue Route and Agreement #119-M0811 are

attached and on file with the Board Clerk.
