Transportation Department recommending adoption of Resolution **170-2008** sanctioning the closure of Marshall Road between Garden Valley Road and Greenwood Road, including approximately 200 feet of Greenwood Road west of the Marshall Road intersection, and approximately 500 feet of Garden Valley Road east of the Marshall Road intersection in Garden Valley on Friday, July 4, 2008, between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. for the "Garden Valley Annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade and Celebration", subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 and conditions set forth in the "Application for Road Closure".
