Fiscal Impact/Change to Net County Cost:

There are no fees or assessments relative to this License Agreement. There is no Fiscal Impact associated with this item. There is no Net County Cost.

Reason for Recommendation:

The Transportation Department (Department) is in the process of implementing the Angora 3 Erosion Control Project (Project), which is currently under construction. The Project improvements include tree removal, curb and gutter with tie-in pavement, sediment traps, drainage inlets, culverts, rocklined channels, grass-lined swales, sod salvage and transplant, porous pavement, sediment basins, and bio-retention areas, humus, mulch, and tackifier applications.

This proposed License Agreement for the Project provides access to one (1) parcel owned by the California Tahoe Conservancy (CTC), APN # 033-443-05. Exhibit A of the License Agreement describes the proposed improvements for this parcel.

The CTC prepared two (2) originals of the License Agreement to grant the County permission to access the CTC-owned parcel.

Action to be taken following Board approval:

- 1. After the Board Chairman signs the two (2) originals of the CTC License Agreement, the Board Clerk will complete the All Purpose Notary Acknowledgment provided.
- 2. The Board Clerk will send the two (2) originals of the License Agreement and the All Purpose Notary Acknowledgment to the Department for processing to the CTC for signature.
