Chief Administrative Office, District Attorney (DA) and Sheriff's Office notifying the Board and making available for review and public comment the County's submission of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Fiscal Year 2018 application for funding of \$19,513 for training and the purchase of a laptop for the Sheriff's Office and training and purchase of body armor and firearms for the DA's office.

FUNDING: Justice Assistance Grant Program.

DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND

The Sheriff's Office is requesting \$9,756.50 to purchase a laptop to assist in becoming National Incident-Based Reporting System compliant and to fund sending six Detectives to the California Narcotic Officers Association Annual Training Institute.

The DA's Office is requesting \$9,756.50 to purchase body armor and firearms, and to fund sending four DA employees to the California District Attorney Investigators' Association Annual Conference.

The U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs Bureau of Justice Assistance, does require that the County notify the Board and make available a copy of the application to allow any public comment in regards to the application.
