Authorize the Chair to sign the Consent to the Making of an Irrevocable Offer of Dedication for a Road Right of Way and Public Service Easement and to record the Irrevocable Offer of Dedication with the Consent attached. Authorization for recording said Offer is pursuant to Government Code Section 7050.

FUNDING: N/A DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

The Surveyor's Office received an application from Kenneth D. Welsh, for an IRREVOCABLE OFFER OF DEDICATION FOR ROAD RIGHT OF WAY AND PUBLIC SERVICE EASEMENT (IOD) on Assessor's Parcel Number 119-090-59, and being more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and depicted on Exhibit "B" of the attached Exhibits.

This dedication is to remain in effect and run with the land until such time as the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of necessity for public purposes and accepts said offer by resolution and is in support of the Bass Lake Specific Plan.
