### FINANCIAL IMPACT

The costs under the current facility use agreement is \$2,087/month and Mother Lode Lions Club has agreed to a lower monthly amount totaling \$1,800/month with an annual increase. It should be noted the County pays \$525/month for use of the Pollock Pines Community Center congregate meal site and \$500/month for utilities in lieu of rent for use of the Greenwood congregate meal site.
