Sheriff's Office recommending the Board approve and authorize the Chair to sign the revenue generating El Dorado County Sheriff's Office Agreement for Supplemental Law Enforcement Services with El Dorado County Union High School District from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

FUNDING: Revenue generating agreement.

DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND

For the past several years, El Dorado Union High School District (EDUHSD) has contracted with the Sheriff's Office to provide a law enforcement presence at various school functions including school dances, sporting events, and other various activities that attract a large crowd of people. The presence of law enforcement is to promote public safety, enhance community support and deter any illegal activity all while protecting those in attendance.

EDUHSD will be charged \$81.55 per staff hour and a 12% administrative fee for services for the duration of the 2021-22 school year.
