- 2) Direct staff to return to the Board within 45 days with a new Board Policy to address the implementation of the Code for all Boards, Commissions and Committees.

DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND

The Code of Civil Discourse, which was first drafted by the National Conflict Resolution Center (NCRC) as a tool for local governments and agencies in 2015, is intended to serve as a guide for facilitating civil, respectful discussions of opposing views during public meetings. Since then, it has been adopted by multiple local government bodies which include the San Diego Unified School Board, the City of Del Mar, the City of Chula Vista, and in November 2021 by the San Diego County Board of Supervisors.
